The Georgia Club is located less than one mile south of University Parkway, Highway 316, off the Craft Road exit in Statham, Georgia, 45 miles east of Atlanta and 10 miles west of Athens.

DETAILS: The Georgia Club Foundation's first annual Christmas Tour of Homes (December 2007) drew more than 850 people to The Georgia Club community and raised \$25,000 for seven local charities including Extra Special People, Interfaith Hospitality Network, Peace Place, Project ADAM, Recording for the Blind and Dyslexic, the Statham Library and The Tree House.
